

BOARD OF DIRECTORS NOMINATIONS

The HLEFCU Board of Directors is comprised of dedicated volunteers who work hard to keep the Credit Union running smoothly.

ELIGIBILITY TO HOLD AN ELECTIVE OFFICE ON THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS IS GRANTED TO AN HLEFCU MEMBER WHO:

- 1) Is at least 18 years of age;
- 2) Is currently in good standing with HLEFCU; and
- 3) Has not been convicted of a crime involving dishonesty or breach of trust.

All applications and nominations were due on December 2nd, 2019. Nominations for vacancies may also be filed by a petition signed by 1% of our HLEFCU members with a minimum of 20 and a maximum of 500 submitted by January 21st, 2020. Nominees filed by petition must include a statement of qualifications and biographical data with the petition.

There will be no nominations from the floor once the number of nominees equals the number of vacancies on our Board. Our annual elections will be held from February 3rd, 2020, through February 15th, 2020, at the Main Branch - 1537 Young Street, Honolulu, Hawaii 96826.

All nominees, including those by petition, must provide a signed statement to agree to the nomination and to serve if elected. The following nominees have met or exceeded the qualifications, provided a statement of qualifications with biographical data and a signed certificate stating that they are agreeable to the nomination and will serve if elected.

CURRENT NOMINEES

Roy Helepololei is a retired Honolulu Police Officer who also served as the Director of Security & Safety for the Sheraton Waikiki.

Over the years, he's served the Credit Union as a Credit Committee from 1990 to 1991, as the Credit Committee Chairperson from 1992 to 2014, and in his current capacity as a Board Director since 2014.
